## Terms and Conditions

The Fremantle City Dockers Junior Football Club Photo Competition is a chance to showcase the on and off field participation of our players, families, and community throughout the season.

All photos will be entered into one of 2 categories:

1. On Field
2. Off Field

The winning entry for each category will receive a Fremantle Dockers prize pack and framed copy of their winning photo to the value of up to \$100.

Entries for both categories will close **11.59pm Sunday 25 August 2024.**

Winners will be judged by a panel of members from the Fremantle City Dockers JFC Executive Committee and announced at the Club wind up on **Sunday 15 September 2024.**

Participants are limited to entering a total of six (6) of their best photographs. Videos will not be accepted.

All photos must be in JPEG format, saved using the largest and finest file settings with a minimum resolution of 1.5 MB (mega-bytes). Photographs cannot include any watermark or signature.

## Terms and Conditions

1. The promoter is Fremantle City Dockers Football Club Incorporated ABN 21 739 504 464 of 138 Lefroy Road, Beaconsfield WA 6163.
2. Information on how to enter forms part of these conditions of entry. Participation in this competition constitutes acceptance of these conditions of entry.
3. Entry is restricted to Western Australian residents only, and winners will be required to verify their address.
4. Photographs must be submitted via email to:

5. Photos must be in JPEG format, saved using the largest and finest file settings with a minimum resolution of 1.5MB (mega-bytes). Photographs cannot include any watermark or signature.
6. Photographs must not depict any behaviour considered unsafe or which contravenes the WAFC's Junior & Youth Rules & Regulations, Rule 1 – Spirit of Junior Football.
7. A person may submit a maximum of six (6) entries.

8. Photographs may be submitted from 00:01am (WA time) 21 June 2023 to 11:59pm (WA time) Sunday 25 August 2024. Entries received after this time and date will be declared invalid.
9. A judging panel comprising of members appointed by the promoter's Executive Committee will determine the winner for each category. Winners will be announced at the Club Wind Up on Sunday 15 September 2024. The decision of the judging panel is final and no correspondence on the final decisions will be entered into. The promoter reserves the right to not award a winner in any one or more categories if it considers that the standard of the entries does not merit an award.
10. The prizes for each category will comprise of a Fremantle Dockers gift pack and framed copy of the winning photo, up to the value of \$100.
11. Each prize is not transferrable or exchangeable for cash.
12. The promoter may publish the name of the winners on its website and social media sites.
13. Submitted photos remain the copyright of the participant. As a condition of entry, the participant grants the promoter the right to reproduce and/or display submitted photos in the promoter's publications and promotions, on the promoter's website, the promoter's social media sites, and the promoter's marketing material.

If for any reason this competition is not capable of running as planned, including due to infection by computer virus, network failure, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures, a reduced number of participants, or any other causes beyond the control of the promoter, the promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition, subject to any written directions of any relevant authority.
